

## The Environmental Studies Major – 4 year plans

The ENVS major consists of two parts: a six course core and a six course concentration. Concentrations can be in environmental policy; environmental science; environment, culture, and society; or individualized. Below, we lay out the requirements for each concentration, and a sample four-year plan.

### Plan 1: Environmental Policy

1. ENVS core: PHIL 140, BIO 151, ENVS 134, POLS 258, ENVS 250, ENVS 485
2. ECON 130 (FY or SO year)
3. ECON 255 (SO or JR spring)
4. POLS 355 (JR or SR fall)
5. POLS 360 (JR spring)
6. One of: POLS 340 (alternate falls); POLS 247 (fall)
7. One of: ENVS 240 (J-term study away); ENVS 248 (alternate falls)

2. CHEM 141 (or 151/152, or 201)
3. BIO 152 or MATH 140 (or above)
4. ENVS 220 (spring)
5. BIO 256 (fall)
6. One of: ENVS 225 (alternate falls); BIO 250, 251\*, 252\*, 258\*
7. One of: ENVS 320 (alternate falls), BIO 365 (fall), BIO 354 (spring)

*\*Has BIO 152 prerequisite*
