- *Your statement of account will show the cost assessed for your program; specific program costs may be obtained from the Center for Global Learning.*
- *You are not considered withdrawn or on academic leave from Luther. (Application for readmission to Luther is not required.)*
- *Luther College will recognize the credits earned in the program (as transfer credits, with the exception of the Washington Consortium program and the Munster Semester) provided the grades earned are C- or above. Courses should be approved on the standard "Course Approval Form" available in the Registrar's Office, or in an equivalent manner, if you are completing major/general requirements with these courses.*
- *Detailed information on all programs, including financial assistance and scholarships, is available in the Center for Global Learning. The amount of financial assistance available will vary from program to program. Students will work with the Financial Aid Office to determine their eligibility.*
- *You are responsible for requesting a final official academic transcript from the host institution, which is to be sent directly to Luther College when the program is completed. The transcript will become a part of your permanent record at Luther.*
