As defined by the U.S. Dept. of Education, a non-resident alien is a person who is not a citizen or national of the United States and who is in this country on a visa or temporary basis and does not have the right to remain indefinitely. Note 3: In accordance with U.S. Department of Education regulations, beginning Fall 2010 the race/ethnic categories shown are those in which we will report our aggregate data. Note 4: In accordance with IPEDS reporting requirements, the First Year Cohort includes all first time, full-time first year degree seeking students. Students who meet this requirement, regardless of the number of advanced standing credits they bring with to Luther, are included in the FY Cohort.
