- 3. Discuss the following with your academic advisor:
 - How does your program of choice fit your personal, academic, and career goals?
 - Does studying off campus fit into your academic schedule?
 - What courses should you plan to take before and after you study off campus?
 - Though most students who study off campus graduate in four years, part of this discussion with your advisor should include what you will do if you do not earn sufficient credits.
 - If necessary, are you willing to take summer classes at Luther or another college/university?
 - o If necessary, are you willing to take an additional semester at Luther?
- 4. Meet with your major department head(s) to review your academic plan.
