Luther's Jazz Orchestra traveled to Brazil, May 25 to June 14, 2016, for a three-week immersion in the musical cultures of Rio de Janeiro and the northeastern states of Paraíba, Pernambuco, and Rio Grande do Norte. The tour featured 13 performances, workshops in Brazilian percussion, dance, choral singing, and frevo, live performances on Brazilian public radio and television, exchanges with amateur and professional ensembles, and several trips to the beach.
