Thursday January 8 **LUTHER Departure.** Meet in front of Jenson-Noble Hall for bus departure to Chicago. Meet your Seminars International representative (6:30 p.m.) at the Lufthansa German Airlines check-in counter, Chicago O'Hare International Airport, Terminal 1 for departure (9:30 p.m.) on Lufthansa German Airlines flight to Munich. See complete group flight details under the Flight Schedule section.

Friday January 9 **SALZBURG Arrival.** Arrive (1:20 p.m.) at Munich International Airport, meet transfer assistant who will escort you to the private motorcoaches for Salzburg. Arrive at the PLAZA ZUM HIRSCHEN HOTEL for check-in. Orientation session (5:45 p.m.) at the hotel in the Salzburger Saal. Walk (6:30 p.m.) to the *Restaurant Stiftskeller St. Peter* for group welcome dinner. **(D)** 

Saturday January 10

**SALZBURG.** Breakfast and meeting in the Salzburger Saal until 10:30 a.m. followed by historical/cultural orientation walking tour of old Salzburg guided by faculty directors with stops at Mirabel Gardens, the Wolf Dietrich Mausoleum, Getreidegasse, the Dom, St. Peter Churchyard, Mozart's Birthplace (11:00 a.m. entrance included) and the Hohensalzburg Fortress (3:00 p.m. entrance, combi-ticket included). Wear good walking shoes/boots. Rest of day free. **(B)** 

Sunday January 11 **SALZBURG/VIENNA.** Morning (7:30 a.m.) departure by private motorcoach to Vienna with en route stop for guided tour (10:00 a.m.) and short film of Mauthausen. Arrive Vienna (3:30 p.m.) for a guided tour of the city and check-in at the HOTEL KUMMER. Orientation in the hotel restaurant including a trial walk to the Veranstaltungszentrum Mariahilf (bring your information booklet, city map and outdoor clothing). Group dinner (7:30 p.m.) at the hotel. Transportation passes provided for duration of Vienna stay. **(B,D)** 

Monday January 12 VIENNA. Breakfast (6:30-10.30 a.m. daily) and announcements followed by departure (8:15 a.m.) to the Veranstaltungszentrum Mariahilf. Rehearsal from (8:45-11:30 a.m.) followed by self-serve buffet lunch (12:00 p.m.) at the hotel. Afternoon (1:30-4:00 p.m.) full rehearsal at the Veranstaltungszentrum Mariahilf. (B,L)

Tuesday January 13 VIENNA. Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, Strings meet for a sectional rehearsal in the Grosser Saal. Winds and Percussion meet with J. Strauss in the Klubsaal for a discussion of the introduction and first two chapters of Paul Hofmann's *The Viennese*. Please be prepared to answer the questions in the study guide and share your observations with the group. (B,L)

Wednesday January 14 **VIENNA.** Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, Winds and Percussion meet for a sectional rehearsal, while Strings meet with J. Strauss in the Klubsaal (available until 3:00 p.m.) for a discussion of the introduction and first two chapters of Paul Hofmann's *The Viennese*. Please be prepared to answer the questions in the study guide and share your observations with the group. **(B,L)** 

Thursday January 15 **VIENNA.** Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, the Strings meet for a sectional rehearsal while the Winds and Brass depart the hotel (1:30 p.m.) for a two-hour guided tour of the Kunsthistorisches Museum. Evening (7:30 p.m.) performance of the Vienna Symphony Orchestra at the Musikverein. **(B,L)** 

Friday January 16 VIENNA. Morning (8:30.-11.00 a.m.) rehearsal followed by a dance lesson. After lunch, the Winds and Brass meet for a sectional rehearsal while the Strings depart the hotel (1:30 p.m.) for a two-hour guided tour of the Kunsthistorisches Museum. Evening attendance at the Officer's Ball at the Wiener Hofburg (doors open at 8:00 p.m., 4 tables reserved). (B,L)

Saturday January 17

**VIENNA.** Free time for independent exploration. Consult your travel packet and see John or Virginia Strauss if you have questions. **(B)** 

Sunday January 18 **VIENNA.** Optional morning church service at the Augustinerkirche or the Jesuitenkirche. Free time for independent exploration. **(B)** 

Monday January 19 **VIENNA.** Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, Strings meet for a sectional while Winds and Brass meet with J. Strauss to discuss the rest of Paul Hofmann's *The Viennese*. Please be prepared to answer the questions in the study guide. **(B,L)** 

Tuesday January 20 **VIENNA.** Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, Winds and Brass meet for a sectional while Strings meet with J. Strauss to discuss the rest of Paul Hofmann's *The Viennese*. Please be prepared to answer the questions in the study guide. Afternoon (5:00-7:00 p.m.) visit to Wien Oberlaa (a modern indoor/outdoor thermal spa with swimming pools, whirl pools, etc.). Group buffet dinner (7:30 p.m.) at *Windisch Heuriger*. (B,L,D)

Wednesday January 21 **VIENNA.** Standard morning schedule. Following lunch depart (1:30 p.m.) the hotel for an afternoon two-hour guided tour of the Belvedere Palace for Group B/Winds/Brass; lecture/sectional rehearsals for Group A/Strings, as arranged by faculty directors. Evening (7:30 p.m.) performance of the *ORF Radio-Symphonieorchester Wien* at the Konzerthaus. **(B,L)** 

Thursday January 22 **VIENNA.** Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, Group B/Winds/Brass meet for a sectional rehearsal while Group A/Strings depart (1:30 p.m.) the hotel for a two-hour guided tour of the Belvedere Palace. **(B,L)** 

Friday January 23 VIENNA. Standard morning schedule. Following lunch, return for rehearsal (1:30-3:00 p.m.). Vans arrive (3:30 p.m.) to collect instruments from Veranstaltungszentrum Mariahilf and deliver to Hotel Kummer for storage. Evening (8:00 p.m.) performance of Salome at the Staatsoper. (B,L)

Saturday January 24 VIENNA. Free time for independent exploration of the city. J. Strauss will lead two tours of the City of Vienna Museum: Strings at 12:00 p.m. and Winds/Brass at 3:00 p.m. Evening (7:00 p.m.) performance of *Carmen* at the Volksoper. (B)

Sunday January 25 VIENNA. Optional morning church service at the Augustinerkirche or the Jesuitenkirche. Optional hike through the Vienna Woods led by John and Virginia Strauss: from Kahlenberg to Pfarrplatz in Heiligenstadt. (B)

Monday January 26 VIENNA (OBERSCHÜTZEN). Morning (8:30-10:30 a.m.) review session at the Veranstaltungszentrum Mariahilf Grosser Saal. Motorcoaches and trailer arrive (11:00 a.m.) at Hotel Kummer to be loaded by students for drive to Oberschützen (about 90 mins). Afternoon (2:30-4:15 p.m.) rehearsal. Early dinner (4:45-5:45 p.m.) at the *Café Restaurant Kulturzentrum*. Evening (7:00-9:30 p.m.) performance at the Kulturzentrum Oberschützen. (B,D)

Tuesday January 27 **VIENNA.** Morning (9:30-11:30 a.m.) final exam on Paul Hofmann's *The Viennese* at the Veranstaltungszentrum Mariahilf, Grosser Saal. Free afternoon for independent exploration. **(B)** 

Wednesday January 28 VIENNA (STOCKERAU). Free morning. Motorcoaches and trailer arrive (11:45 a.m.) at Hotel Kummer to be loaded by students for drive to Stockerau (about 40 mins). Afternoon (2:30-4:15 p.m.) rehearsal. Early dinner (4:45-5:45 p.m.) at Stadtsaal Stockerau. Evening (7:00-9:30 p.m.) performance at the Concert Hall. (B,D)

Thursday January 29 **VIENNA.** Instrument vans arrive (7:00 a.m.) at Hotel Kummer to transport instruments and crates from hotel to the Konzerthaus for morning (9:30 a.m.-12:30 p.m.) rehearsal. Afternoon free. Motorcoach transfer (4:45 p.m.) to the Konzerthaus for evening performance (7:00 p.m.) (Recorded for personal use), followed by transfer to *StadtParkBrāu* for late (10:15 p.m.) dinner. **(B,D)** 

Friday January 30 **VIENNA/MUNICH.** Morning (9:00 a.m.) departure by private motorcoach for Munich, with check-in-upon arrival at the BEST WESTERN CRISTAL HOTEL. **(B)** 

Saturday January 31 **MUNICH.** Morning (9:00 a.m.) departure by private motorcoach for a guided tour of the city including entrances (10:30 a.m.) to the Alte and Neue Pinakotek. Afternoon at leisure. Farewell (7:00 p.m.) buffet dinner at Restaurant Augustiner Gaststaette. (B,D)

Sunday February 1 MUNICH/CHICAGO. Morning (11:30 a.m.) transfer by private motorcoach to Munich International Airport for departure (3:40 p.m.) on Lufthansa German Airlines flight LH #434 for Chicago. Arrive (6:55 p.m.) at Chicago O'Hare International Airport, Terminal 5 for customs clearance. Return bus service to Luther College. (B)
